Acting Assistant Inspector General for Audit

In May 2004 Carol Bates was appointed to the position of Acting Assistant Inspector General for Audit. She has served as Audit Manager in the Office of Inspector General at the Corporation for National and Community Service since April 15, 2002.

Before assuming her position at the Corporation, Mrs. Bates was employed by the Defense Contract Audit Agency (DCAA). Mrs. Bates began her Government career as a clerk typist and worked her way to the position of Supervisory Auditor. As an audit supervisor she was responsible for the quality and timeliness of the her team's audits, compliance with applicable Federal audit guidelines, establishing the team's annual audit plan and accuracy of the management information and statistics regarding staff accomplishments. Mrs. Bates periodically served as a DCAA recruiter.

Mrs. Bates was born in Orange, New Jersey. She received a Bachelor's Degree in Education from the University in Maryland in 1976 and an Accounting Degree from the University of Maryland University College in 1978.
